

# Data Breaches Are a Threat in 2022

**2021**

Data breach cost raised to **\$4.24M**

The average data breach cost rising from \$3.86 million to \$4.24 million on an annual basis.  
(IBM Cost of a Data Breach Report 2021)

**1,862** breaches

There were 1,862 breaches in 2021, up 68% from 2020.  
(Identity Theft Resource Center's 2021 Data Breach Report)

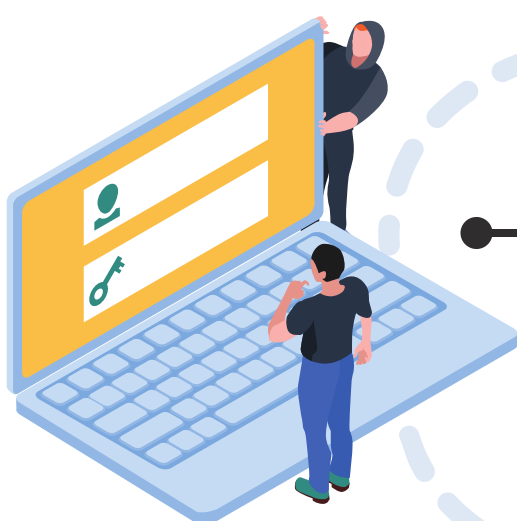

## Major Data Breaches in 2022 (so far)



### Cyrpto.com - January 17th

A 2FA comprise led to a multimillion-loss hack that impacted 483 users and resulted in unauthorized withdrawals of Bitcoin, Ether, and other currencies of around \$34 million.



### Axis - February 21st

After dodging Axis' protective mechanisms such as multi-factor authentication, hackers gained access to internal directory services and compromised important parts of their server infrastructure.

### Okta - March 21st

Lapsus\$, a ransomware group, gained access through a third-party vendor and published screenshots of Okta's internal systems. Okta faced criticism for its delayed disclosure, acknowledging the breach 2 months after the attack.



### Cash App - April 4th

A former employee gained access, without permission, to reports that contained user's full names, brokerage account numbers, brokerage portfolio value, portfolio holdings, and stock trading for that day.
